

Numerous showers and thunderstorms are possible overnight, mainly after 3AM. A few strong to severe thunderstorms are possible Wednesday morning, mainly across the western Concho Valley and Big Country, along with Crockett County. The main hazards will be large hail, damaging winds and locally heavy rainfall, which may result in flooding.

A strong cold front this weekend will likely bring the coolest temperatures of the season to the area next week with widespread lows in the 30s Tuesday and Wednesday mornings. Some locations may get close to their first freeze of the season.

Large Language Models (LLM)

- In response to a request from NWS Director, can a LLM be used to better communicate with the underserved?
- As a leader in LLM AI technology: A good potential use could be as a "copilot" to mimic a multitude of user personas to better "speak their language" vs. NWS assumed user understandings.
- Using LLM could greatly improve the efficiency of forecast preparations and awareness from citizens.
- LLM can also serve as a translation pilot for NWS warnings and texts.





Gemba

Gemba (現場) is the Japanese term for "actual place," often used for the shop floor or any place where value-creating work actually occurs. Japanese companies often supplement gemba with the related term "genchi gembutsu" — essentially "go and see" — to stress the importance of empiricism.

A gemba walk is a management practice for grasping the current situation through direct observation and inquiry before taking action.

Tragic example: Marshall Fire: Dec 30, 2021





The Most Destructive fire in Colorado History

- Driven by winds gusting to 115 mph, this fire destroyed
 1084 structures, killed 2 people, and cost \$2 Billion.
- AMS Summer presentation: there were weather stations 'up canyon' that recorded the winds
- These weren't official stations, nor trusted to use in model training
- Some forecast models hinted at the wind potential but none to the extremes that occurred
- How are our models going to improve if we don't train them with actual conditions from where our citizens are?

Global High Density Reference Network









- ML/Al emerging technologies are strongly reliant on the quality of the training data. Garbage in= Garbage out.
- ASOS and AWOS represents the "gold standard" but too costly
- IoT, PWS, Big Data to the rescue? How do we trust the data? QC challenges
- National Mesonet is a good start but we need more investment in data collection, standards, and QC
- Today's weather data is tomorrow's climate record
 & used to verify and train ML/AI algorithms.

How can AI help enhance delivery in day to day forecast operations?

- Timeliness of model updates- Goal: No idle time
 - Example: 5 minute model refresh + 2-4 minute nowcasting
- Trust in model outputs- Goal: Fire and forget
 - Continuous model for every day use (no special models)
 - Fast model iterations based on Meteorologist feedback
 - Integration of increasing vetted QC observations for continuous learning
 - Situational analysis to weight initialization algorithms on weather scenarios
- LLM "forecast pilot" Goal: maximize efficiency
 - Remove the mundane tasks so forecaster can focus on the "critical few"
 - Seamless delivery to end user with minimal overhead

How can AI help enhance delivery in severe weather operations?

- o If daily weather is mostly on "autopilot", this frees up resources to focus on severe weather
- Trust in model outputs
 - Continuous model for every day use will instill confidence from forecasters
 - Situational analysis + algorithms tuned to weather type that is happening
 - Tropical Cyclone modeling largely ML already
 - Fast updates to keep stakeholders updated with refreshed analysis and timely forecasts
- LLM Goal: maximize efficiency and communications to underserved
 - Persona mimicking
 - Automatic translations
